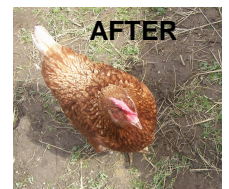
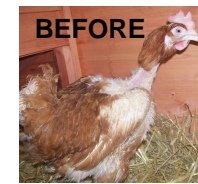
If it was not for a kind member of the public who heard them screaming these four kittens may of died. The kittens were placed in the maternity unit where they were kept warm and fed.

All four kittens survived and have now found loving new homes.

BATTERY HEN STORY

Animal Care rescued four hens in November 2009 Heather, Hilary, Hazel and Henrietta arrived in a terrible condition.

They had little to no feathers and instead there were red raw sore patches, which are due to a life time spent in a tiny unclean area. They had no clue how to use their wings or how to walk.



This latest photo was taken in April and as you can see they have grown all their feathers back and the red sores have all gone. Our hens have a large outdoor area which they love to roam about in and also have a warm safe indoor hut which they sleep in each night.

The four girls have now been rehomed and we are now rescuing more and more battery hens from this terrible life. To carry on this work we rely on the public and kind donations.

How can people do such terrible things to these animals you may ask. The four hens are only **one of many cases** where we pay medical costs for. It may be an old dog on tablets, a cat in need of a dental or a rabbit with eye problems. Our vet bill is approximately **£50,000-£60,000 a year** so please help us help the abandoned and unwanted animals.
